

ORDINANCE NO. 597

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DATE FOR APPOINTING COMMITTEES; AMENDING SECTION 1 (MEMBERSHIP, TERM, QUALIFICATION AND COMPENSATION) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 513 ; AND AMENDING SECTION 2 (MEMBERSHIP) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 555 OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS; PERTAINING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, desires to change the date for the appointment of its various committees to the same date annually so that appointments to committees can be handled uniformly at the same time each year by the Governing Body, as opposed to appointments being made at various times throughout the year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That all committee appointments shall be made at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May of each year, except for those committees whose appointment dates are set specifically by State or Federal statute.

SECTION 2. That the anniversary date for all such appointments shall be the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May of the year in which any such appointment is set to expire.

SECTION 3. Section 1 of Ordinance 513 of the City of SEDGWICK, Kansas, is hereby amended from:

SECTION 1: Membership, term, qualification and compensation. The Sedgwick City Economic Development Advisory Commission shall consist of seven (7) members of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Sedgwick by and with the consent of the City Council of the City of Sedgwick. All terms shall commence on January 1 and expire on December 31 of odd numbered years. All terms of office other than the terms of the initial appointees shall be for two (2) years and until their successors shall have been duly appointed and qualified. A vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of a member in the same manner as the original appointment.

Any person residing within the City of Sedgwick shall be eligible for appointment by the City of Sedgwick. Any person residing within Harvey and or Sedgwick, Counties (including incorporated areas) shall also be eligible for appointment. Members of the Sedgwick City Economic Development Advisory Commission shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses actually incurred in the performance of their duties as members of the Commission.

The Economic Development Advisory Commission may designate such ex officio members as it deems appropriate who shall have the right to attend and participate but who shall not vote.

SECTION 1: Membership, term, qualification and compensation. The Sedgwick City Economic Development Advisory Commission shall consist of seven (7) members of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Sedgwick by and with the consent of the City Council of the City of Sedgwick. All terms shall commence on the date of the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May and expire on the date of the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May of odd numbered years. All terms of office other than the terms of the initial appointees shall be for two (2) years and until their successors shall have been duly appointed and qualified. A vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of a member in the same manner as the original appointment.

Any person residing within the City of Sedgwick shall be eligible for appointment by the City of Sedgwick. Any person residing within Harvey and or Sedgwick, Counties (including incorporated areas) shall also be eligible for appointment. Members of the Sedgwick City Economic Development Advisory Commission shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses actually incurred in the performance of their duties as members of the Commission.

The Economic Development Advisory Commission may designate such ex officio members as it deems appropriate who shall have the right to attend and participate but who shall not vote.

SECTION 4. Section 2 of Ordinance 555 of the City of SEDGWICK, Kansas, is hereby amended from:

SECTION 2: Same-Membership, Terms and Compensation. The Sedgwick Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Mayor of the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, by and with the consent of the City Council. Five (5) members of the Commission shall reside inside the corporate limits, and one (1) member shall reside outside the corporate limits and one (1) member shall be designated "at large" and may reside inside or outside the corporate limits of the City of Sedgwick. All terms of the members shall commence on September 1 and expire on the last day of August. All terms of office other than the terms of the initial appointees shall be for (3) years and until their successors shall have been duly appointed and qualified. Any and all vacancies created by the death, incapacity, resignation or disqualification of any member of the Commission shall be filled by appointment as herein provided for the unexpired term of such deceased, incapacitated, resigned or disqualified member. The members of the Planning Commission shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses actually incurred in the performance of their duties as members of the Sedgwick Planning Commission.

to:

SECTION 2: Same-Membership, Terms and Compensation. The Sedgwick Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the Mayor of the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, by and with the consent of the City Council. Five (5) members of the Commission shall reside inside the corporate limits, and one (1) member shall reside outside the corporate limits and one (1) member shall be designated "at large" and may reside inside or outside the corporate limits of the City of Sedgwick. All terms of the members shall

commence on the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May of each year and expire on the first regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council in May of the following year. All terms of office other than the terms of the initial appointees shall be for (3) years and until their successors shall have been duly appointed and qualified. Any and all vacancies created by the death, incapacity, resignation or disqualification of any member of the Commission shall be filled by appointment as herein provided for the unexpired term of such deceased, incapacitated, resigned or disqualified member. The members of the Planning Commission shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses actually incurred in the performance of their duties as members of the Sedgwick Planning Commission.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
