AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE 1997 EDITIONS OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE AND THE 1996 EDITION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE FOR THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS, COUNTIES OF HARVEY AND SEDGWICK; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 583, SECTIONS I, II, III AND V TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS.

REFERENCE: THERE is hereby adopted by The City of Sedgwick the 1997 edition of The Uniform Building Code, Volumes 1,2 and 3, regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, moving, removal, demolition, conversion, occupancy, equipment, use, height, area and maintenance of all buildings or structures in the City of Sedgwick. Three copies of which are now on file in the Office of the City Clerk as provided by law.

REFERENCE: THERE is hereby adopted by The City of Sedgwick the 1997 edition of The Uniform Plumbing Code, regulating and controlling the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of any plumbing system in the City of Sedgwick. Three copies of which are now on file in the Office of the City Clerk as provided by law.

SECTION III: ADOPTION OF THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1997 EDITION BY REFERENCE: THERE is hereby adopted by the City of Sedgwick the 1997 edition of The Uniform Mechanical Code, regulating and controlling the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of heating, ventilating, cooling, refrigeration systems, incinerators, or other miscellaneous heat-producing appliances in the City of Sedgwick. Three copies of which are now on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

SECTION V: ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1996 EDITION BY REFERENCE: THERE is hereby adopted by the City of Sedgwick the 1996 edition of The National Electrical Code, the purpose of which is the practical safeguarding of persons and property from hazards arising from the use of electricity. Three copies of which are now on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in The Harvey County Independent, The official city newspaper for The City of Sedgwick.
