

ORDINANCE NO. 669

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF TRUCKS, BUSES, TRAILERS, TRUCK TRACTORS, SEMI-TRAILER, OR THE TRAILER COMPONENTS THEREOF, UPON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS WITHIN THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 656 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Sedgwick wishes to establish its ordinance prohibiting the parking of trucks, busses, trailers, truck tractors, semi-trailer, or the trailer components thereof, upon the streets and alleys within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any truck with a registered gross weight exceeding 24,000 pounds, or any bus, trailer, truck tractor, semi-truck tractor, semi-trailer, or the trailer component thereof regardless of weight, upon any street or alley in the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, except as provided in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. (a) Any truck, bus, trailer, truck tractor, semi-trailer, or the trailer component thereof, may be parked on any street or alley in the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, for so long as may be necessary to make deliveries of cargo therefrom to stores, residences or business establishments in said city, or to load cargo into such trailers for said premises for delivery elsewhere.

(b) An exception of eight (8) hours to this ordinance shall apply to the parking of trucks, busses, trailers, truck tractors, semi-trailers or the trailer components thereof, in case of breakdown or emergency necessitating such parking.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of Ordinance 656 of the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 4. General Penalties. Every person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, for the first conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00); and for a subsequent conviction within a one (1) year thereafter, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). Upon a third or subsequent conviction within a one(1) year period after the first conviction such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that each day violation constitutes a new separate offense.

SECTION 5. Repeal. All ordinances of the Code of the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its required publication.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be published in the official city newspaper, the Harvey County Independent.
