

ORDINANCE NO. 694

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS, CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF THE STORAGE OF INOPERABLE VEHICLES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Original Section 6 of Ordinance 635 as adopted by the City of Sedgwick, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more then \$500.00, plus \$25.00 per day for each day the violation continues. Additionally, the City, through law enforcement and its appointed agents, may choose to notify the owner of the abandoned/inoperable vehicle located on public right of way or publicly owned property that the vehicle will be impounded at the end of seventy-two (72) hours at the expense of the rightful owner. Such notice shall be conspicuously posted upon the abandoned/inoperable vehicle and delivered to the last known address of the rightful owner.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in THE HARVEY COUNTY INDEPENDENT, the official newspaper of said City.
