

**ORDINANCE NO. 712**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, HARVEY AND SEDGWICK COUNTIES, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 600; CHANGING ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3.K. OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1. Ordinance 600, Article IV, Section 3.K. is changed to read as follows:**

**ARTICLE IV.**

**Section 3.K.**

Minimum Requirements. All streets, alleys and public ways, included in any subdivision, hereafter dedicated and accepted, shall not be less than the minimum dimensions for each classification as follows:

<u>Streets</u>	<u>Right-of-Way Width</u>	<u>Minimum Pavement Width</u> (Back of curb to back of curb)
Arterials	100 ft.	45 ft.
Collectors	80 ft.	39 ft.
Local Streets	60 ft.	35 ft. (No parking restrictions)
Cul-de-Sacs	50 ft.	35 ft. (No parking)
<u>Manufactured Home Parks</u>		
Cul-de-Sacs	60 ft.	35 ft.
Local Streets	50 ft.	35 ft.


Radius on Turn Around (No Parking Restrictions)

**In local streets and cul-de-sacs, when a petition restricts parking to only one side of the street or no parking on either side of the street, the minimum pavement width shall be 31 ft.**

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its once publication in the Harvey County Independent, the official City newspaper.
