

ORDINANCE NO. 741

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF ABOVEGROUND STATIONARY LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS STORAGE TANKS WITHIN THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS AND REPEALING ALL OTHER AND FOREGOING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WHEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE OF THE CITY OF SEDGWICK, KANSAS.

Section 1. All liquefied petroleum gas storage tanks and the use thereof are prohibited within the city limits of Sedgwick, Kansas.

Section 2. This prohibition shall not apply to uses such as standard barbecue grills for personal use, those portable tanks used for recreational vehicles, or those mounted and used for operation of propane-powered vehicles.

Section 3. This prohibition shall not apply to use of standard heating tanks used by construction companies and contractors for temporary installation on a building site. This use shall be limited to a period not to exceed forty-five (45) days and must be approved by the fire chief prior to use.

Section 4. Upon proper application and for good cause and exception shown, the Governing Body may grant a conditional use permit to locate a generally prohibited storage tank under conditions that the Governing Body may prescribe.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage by the Governing Body and publication in the official city newspaper.
